STAIRCASE MEASURING GUIDE for Straight Stairlifts

In order to ensure that your Straight Stairlift installation goes smoothly, it is imperative that proper and accurate measurements are provided. If you have any questions, or would like some assistance with measuring your staircase, please call **Customer Service**.

1. Overall Length

Stand at the top of your stairs, extend your tape measure until it is laying on all the stair treads and the tip of the tape measure is touching the landing at the bottom of the steps.

2. Top Stair to Bottom Stair

Stand at the top of your stairs, extend your tape measure until it is laying on all the stair treads and the tip of the tape measure is touching the landing at the bottom of the steps.

3. Staircase Width

Measure the width of your staircase and enter the measurement.

4. Bottom Clearance
